## PUD Federal Credit Union Scholarship Policy

Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each are available for post secondary education to attend a college, university, technical, business or trade school.

## The applicant:

- must currently be a member of PUD Federal Credit Union. If not a member, the eligible applicant can join the credit union by completing the necessary steps for credit union membership.
- must currently be a senior in high school or now/will be attending college in the next academic year
- must be considered a full time student.
- must not be over the age of 23 by application deadline.

The application deadline is April 30. A random drawing will be held at the monthly Board of Directors meeting in May. At that time, the winners and 2 alternate names will be drawn.

Scholarship funds are good for one academic year and can be distributed on a quarterly or semester basis. The funds are to be used for tuition, books, or room and board only. The recipient must supply the credit union with a statement showing balance due for tuition or room and board. Payment will be made directly to the school unless the recipient provides a statement showing that the qualifying amounts have been paid. The cost of books will be reimbursed with proof of purchase.

If the recipient of the scholarship does not commit to attending school by fall quarter, funds will be available to the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up. Any unused money will go back to the scholarship fund.

New applications must be submitted each year. The recipients of the scholarships will be ineligible to reapply.
